## Ride Grades

The Club has adopt the following ride grades for off road trail riding.

There are four grades and the expectation for each grade and the minimum type of bike required.

**Adventure Touring** - Mostly open and relatively easy dirt roads. Rides will generally be of a longer distance but will offer include some sight-seeing along the way. (Dual sports bikes - such as Tenere's, BMW's, KTM's etc.)

**Easy Grade** - An easier dirt bike ride of mostly open fire trails for those with little or no dirt bike riding experience.

May include a few obstacles but assistance will be provided if required. (Trail Bike)

**Medium Grade** - General trail ride for the competent rider with a well-maintained bike. May include single tracks, obstacles, river crossings, harder hills, etc. Carry all your own equipment and have your bike well prepared. (Trail/Enduro B)

**Hard Grade** - Difficult and/or long ride recommended for experienced riders only. Carry all you own equipment and have your bike well prepared. Contact ride leader for details. (Enduro Bike)
